



Dear Mounted Reenactors:

We need your help to make adequate preparations for equine participants in the 2019 reenactment. **We require all mounted reenactors to register BY MAY 24th.** NO WALK-ONS! If you are registering with a unit, rather than individually, please note which individual(s) will be bringing horses by adding (M) before their first name on the registration form.

Our registration form has been updated this year! You will see there is a button on the form to upload Coggins tests. We understand most vet clinics are switching to digital forms, so we felt this would be an easy way to send us your paperwork. Each horse **MUST** have a negative Coggins test *valid through June 2nd, 2019* in order to participate in the event. Should we not receive a digital copy, you are required to present an *up-to-date* certificate at the registration tent immediately upon arrival. Anyone failing to produce this certificate will be prohibited from remaining on the property. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Your Equine Activity Liability Release form will also be available to sign online.

There have been no recent outbreaks of communicable disease in our immediate area, but we advise you to consider a full range of vaccinations or boosters for your animals nonetheless. Horses that are not fully vaccinated *are* permitted with *all horse owners* taking full responsibility for the associated risks.

We will be pleased to provide hay for mounted reenactors. If you plan to bring your own hay please notify us you are doing so. We thank you in advance for not having to transport bales unnecessarily.

No communal water or food troughs will be made available. Each horse should have its own feed and water container (or unit members may arrange for containers to be shared among themselves).
