



Dear Unit Representatives and Reenactors,

On behalf of Harrison Tyler and the planning committee, I am delighted to invite you and your unit to participate in the 23<sup>rd</sup> annual reenactment of the Action at Wilson's Wharf. Through your support, Fort Pocahontas will be brought to life on June 6 & 7, 2020, and the historic events which took place 156 years ago on May 24, 1864 will be remembered.

United States Colored Troops are particularly important to the history of the site, therefore registration fees are waived for members of those units. A strong artillery presence is needed for both battles; a bounty of \$150 per gun will be offered to the first 4 full-size guns registered. Cavalry is also very important to the history of the site and success of the event. Advance registration by May 29<sup>th</sup> is required for equine reenactors. Infantry units have a highly visible role reenacting the assault on the fort. Sutlers and civilian interpreters contribute to an authentic atmosphere and are, as always, welcome. There is no additional sutler fee.

Registrations received by May 29<sup>th</sup> are eligible for a discounted rate of \$10 per person. After May 29<sup>th</sup>, the fee is \$15 per person.
