Dear Unit Representatives and Reenactors,

On behalf of Harrison R. Tyler and the planning committee, I would like to extend an invitation to you and your unit to participate in the 2022 reenactment of the Action at Wilson's Wharf. We had a fantastic turnout and event in 2021 and through your support, we hope to again honor the memory of those who fought on May 24, 1864 and bring the battle to life. The event is scheduled for June 4 & 5, 2022.

United States Colored Troops are particularly important to the history of the site, therefore registration fees are waived for members of those units. A strong artillery presence is needed for both battles; a bounty of \$150 per gun will be offered to the first 8 full-size guns registered. Cavalry is also very important to the history of the site and success of the event. Infantry units have a highly visible role reenacting the assault on the fort. Sutlers and civilian interpreters contribute to an authentic atmosphere and are, as always, welcome.

Early registration starts on January 10th with a discounted rate of \$10 per person. After April 15th, the fee is \$20 per person. We are offering a dinner this year at \$10 per plate.
