Registration

- You must pre-register via our online registration form to be admitted to the event.
- Links to electronic waivers will be emailed to all registrants. You must complete waivers electronically to be admitted to the event.
- Tickets for Saturday evening dinner (\$10 per person) must be purchased via our online registration form. DEADLINE: MAY 15TH.
- Substitutions within unit rosters must be made May 23-27.
- No refunds for registrants who do not attend.

Check-In

- Property will open Friday, June 3 at 10am. NO EARLY ARRIVALS.
- Friday, June 3: 10am to midnight
- Saturday, June 4: 6am to 9am
- Sunday, June 5: 7am to 9am

On Site

- ANIMALS (other than registered horses) are NOT PERMITTED. Exceptions for service animals must be arranged in advance.
- Vehicles are STRICTLY PROHIBITED in camp 9:30am Saturday to 2pm Sunday.
- Straw will be available for purchase at check-in tent.
- Ice will be available for purchase at Binford House 10am-noon and 2-4pm Saturday, 10am-noon Sunday.
- Firewood and drinking water are provided.
- Hay is provided for horses.
- Campsites will be assigned. No wall tents without prior authorization.
- Chez Ray food truck will be on site offering drinks and lunch 10:30am-3pm Saturday and Sunday.
